ORDINANCE NO. 02-3-1

An ordinance approving and authorizing the establishment of a Home Occupation for Mark McCullough for special permission to operate "Bayou Electrical Services" – an electrical contracting office at 222 Arlington Drive, Luling, La.

THE ST. CHARLES PARISH COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS:

WHEREAS, the St. Charles Parish Council has established the requirement of both Planning and Zoning Commission and Council approval for those home occupations requiring a state agency review for such operations; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed home occupation of Mark McCullough would require a Louisiana Occupational License for operating an electrical contracting business.

THE ST. CHARLES PARISH COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS;

SECTION I. That the described home occupation application by Mark McCullough, 222 Arlington Drive, Luling, La., is for "Bayou Electrical Services" an electrical contracting business.

SECTION II. That the Department of Planning & Zoning is hereby authorized to grant Mark McCullough a home occupation permit for an electrical contracting business.
