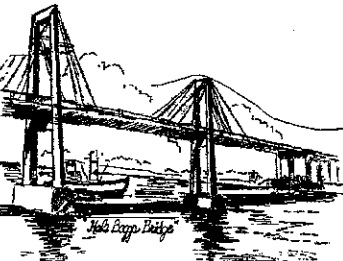
Councilwoman *Fletcher* is a graduate of Destrehan High School and attended the University of New Orleans.



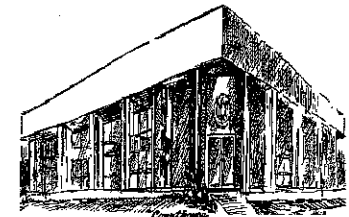
