An ordinance approving and authorizing the execution of Change Order No. One (1) for Parish Project No. P970703 Paul Maillard Road/Boutte Canal Crossing to increase the contract amount by \$3,864.00 and to increase the contract time by 45 days.

SECTION I. Ordinance No. 99-9-4 adopted September 7, 1999 by the St.

Charles Parish Council, approved and authorized the execution of a contract with Civil Construction Contractors, Inc. for the construction of the Paul Maillard Road/Boutte Canal Crossing in the amount of \$305,644.00.

SECTION II. That it is necessary to amend the contract to add 80 feet of 18 inch casing for a 10 inch water line and to increase the contract time by 45 calendar days to account for change order coordination and procurement of material.

SECTION III. That it is necessary to increase the contract amount by \$3,864.00 and increase the contract time by 45 calendar days.
