Dear Mrs. Ford:

We have reviewed the bids received on December 9<sup>th</sup>, 2025 for the above-mentioned project. There were a total of (4) bids received. In review of the bid documents submitted (1) one bid has been disqualified submitted by Couvillion Group, LLC. This bid has been disqualified for failure to utilize the proper LA Uniform Public Works Bid Form as provided in Addendum 2. In addition to failure to utilize the proper bid form, Couvillion Group, LLC failed to acknowledge receipt of both Addenda released for the project, Addendum 1 and Addendum 2.

In review of the provided bids, the apparent low bidder for the project is Curran Co, LLC of Harvey, LA. Curran Co presented an apparent low base bid of \$1,317,351.80 and an Alternate 1 bid of \$190,413.24 for a grand total, representing the overall apparent low bid value of \$1,507,765.04. It is recommended that the Parish accept this base bid and alternate 1 and proceed with contracting with Curran Co, LLC.

A certified bid tabulation and supporting documentation is enclosed with this letter.

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Brett,

Thank you for taking my call this morning and providing insight into contract compliance.

As discussed on the phone, the qualifications of bidders per our contract documents are as follows:

“Bidders on projects in the amount of fifty thousand dollars or more shall be required to have a Louisiana Contractors license for Municipal and Public Works Construction and/or any other classification applicable to the work in compliance with the Louisiana State Licensing Board for Contractors and in compliance with LA RS 37:2150.”

We recently had bid opening on Tuesday of this week and our apparent lowest bidder currently has contractor licenses in the following categories:

- Dredging
- Earthwork, Drainage, and Levees
- Coastal Restoration and Habitat Enhancement
- Limited Specialty Services

The following was advertised to bidders and is considered the scope of our project:

“The project is intended to clean, and strengthen where necessary, the existing drainage canal that runs adjacent to Primrose Dr in Luling, LA. The existing canal has become overgrown with vegetation and has experienced bank failures and erosion at various locations along its length. The canal will be strengthened by sheet pile walls and cleaned where applicable. In addition to the above-mentioned work of sheet pile work the drainage pump station near the intersection of Lagatutta Dr. and Primrose Dr discharge lines will be rerouted”

As we discussed in our phone call this morning, the apparent lowest bidders licenses noted above will be sufficient to award this project. Furthermore with the classifications he holds limited specialty services would encompass the steel sheetpile work, dredging would encompass the excavation and cleaning of the canal, and earthwork, drainage, and levees would encompass work to be performed on the pump station and that these classifications held shall suffice as “applicable” to the work as mentioned in the contract documents and that it is the opinion of the contracting board that no issues would arise should this project be awarded to the apparent lowest bidder.

Please response to this message in agreement or if I have mischaracterized our conversation and the opinions expressed.
