SERVITUDE AGREEMENT

SALLY LAMBERT SCHEXNAYDRE (XXX-XX-7085), (16.67% interest, separate property, subject to usufruct in favor of Martha King Lambert), being a person of the full age of majority and a resident of St. Charles Parish, State of Louisiana who declared that she has been married but once to Bruce A. Schexnaydre, with whom she lives and resides, and whose mailing address is 8 Pinto Lane, St. Rose, Louisiana 70087,

EDWARD W. LAMBERT, JR. (XXX-XX-5468), (16.67% interest, separate property, subject to usufruct in favor of Martha King Lambert), being a person of the full age of majority and a resident of St. Charles Parish, State of Louisiana who declared that he has been married but once to Brian L. MARY JANE LAMBERT (XXX-XX-5436), (16.66% interest, separate property, subject to usufruct in favor of Martha King Lambert), being a person of the full age of majority and a resident of Montgomery County, State of Texas who declared that she has been married but once to Rhonda S. Worthen, with whom she lives and resides, and whose mailing address is 25750 Fish Road, Magnolia, Texas 77355,

Hereinafter designated as "GRANTOR" whether individually or collectively, and;

ST. CHARLES PARISH, a political subdivision of the State of Louisiana, herein represented by Matthew Jewell, its Parish President, appearing herein pursuant to Ordinance No. 23-3-7, adopted by the St. Charles Parish Council on the 27th day of March, 2023, a certified copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, whose mailing address is P.O. Box 302, Hahnville, LA 70057 (hereinafter designated as "GRANTEE").

For the consideration of the benefits, uses and advantages accruing to GRANTOR by reason of the "Project", known as St. Rose Sewer Network Upgrade, St. Charles Parish, Louisiana, and for and upon such other terms and conditions or considerations hereinafter expressed does hereby grant, transfer, assign, set over and deliver unto the GRANTEE a perpetual and assignable servitude and right-of-way in, on over and across the land to locate, construct, maintain, repair, operate, patrol and replace a sewer line, including all appurtenances thereto; reserving, however, to the owners, their heirs and assigns, all such rights and privileges in the land as may be used without interfering with or abridging the rights, servitudes and easements hereby acquired;

subject, however, to existing easements for public roads and highways, public utilities, railroads and pipelines, said perpetual sewer servitude across the lands described below:

LEGAL DESCRIPTION PERPETUAL SEWER SERVITUDE ACROSS LOT 7 OF THE JOHN LAMBERT TRACT

That piece or portion of ground being a 10' Sewer Servitude across Lot 7 of the John Lambert Tract situated in Section 41, T-12-S, R-9-E, St. Rose, St. Charles Parish, Louisiana per a survey plat entitled "Survey Plat of a 10' Sewer Servitude & a 15' Construction Servitude across Lot 7 of the John Lambert Tract with reference to St. Charles Parish Department of Waste Water Project Number S150301, St. Rose Sewer Network Upgrade" by Stephen P. Flynn, P.L.S. dated February 1, 2018, revised May 27, 2020 that is attached hereto and made a part hereof and being more fully described as follows:

Commence at a point being the south right of way of Illinois Central Railroad at Station 101+00.00 having coordinates Northing 533550.75 ft. and Easting 3603456.61 ft. as based on the Louisiana Coordinate System of 1983 South Zone, North American Datum of 1983 as are all the coordinates, bearing and distances in this description;

Thence proceed in a northeasterly direction along the south right of way of Illinois Central Railroad a bearing of N48°57'51"E a distance of 1059.69' to a point at Station 110+59.69, having coordinates of Northing 534246.46 ft. and Easting 3604255.93 ft.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said rights, servitude, and easement hereby conveyed for the sewer servitude across LOT 7 OF THE JOHN LAMBERT TRACT unto said GRANTEE, its successors and assigns in perpetuity.

Additionally, GRANTOR agrees to grant, transfer, assign, set over and deliver unto the GRANTEE a temporary construction servitude or easement to locate and construct a sewer line, including all appurtenances thereto; reserving, however, to the owners, their heirs and assigns, all such rights and privileges in the land as may be used without interfering with or abridging the

rights, servitudes and easements hereby acquired; subject, however, to existing easements for public roads and highways, public utilities, railroads and pipelines, said temporary servitude is for a period of one year beginning at the issuance of notice to proceed to the selected contractor for the identified project across lands described below:

That piece or portion of ground being a 15' Construction Servitude across Lot 7 of the John Lambert Tract situated in Section 41, T-12-S, R-9-E, St. Rose, St. Charles Parish, Louisiana per a survey plat entitled "Survey Plat of a 10' Sewer Servitude & a 15' Construction Servitude across Lot 7 of the John Lambert Tract with reference to St. Charles Parish Department of Waste Water Project Number S150301, St. Rose Sewer Network Upgrade" by Stephen P. Flynn, P.L.S. dated February 1, 2018, revised May 27, 2020 that is attached hereto and made a part hereof and being more fully described as follows:

Thence proceed in a southeasterly direction along the west line of a 10' Sewer Servitude being the west line of Lot 7 of the John Lambert Tract and the east line of Lot 6 of the John Lambert Tract a bearing of \$20°35'04"E a distance of 10.67' to a point at Station 110+55.96, Offset 10.00 R, having coordinates of Northing 534236.47 ft. and Easting 3604259.69 ft.

Thence proceed in a southwesterly direction along the south line of a 15' Construction Servitude a bearing of \$48°57'51"W a distance of 147.59' to a point;

Thence proceed in a northwesterly direction along the west line of a 15' Construction Servitude being the west line of Lot 7 of the John Lambert Tract being the east line of Lot 6 of the John Lambert Tract a bearing of N20°35'04"W a distance of 16.01' to a point

Being a portion of the same property acquired by GRANTOR by Cash Sale from Anna B. Lambert Dwyer, et al dated September 8, 1977 and recorded on September 13, 1977 in COB 194, Folio 114, Instrument No. 56758, St. Charles Parish, Louisiana and further acquired by Judgment of Possession in the Succession of Edward Walter Lambert dated January 2, 1991 and recorded on January 3, 1991 in COB 432, Folio 594, Instrument No. 154795, St. Charles Parish, Louisiana.

It is understood and agreed that, in the construction and maintenance of said project, the GRANTEE may move to or remove from the property herein described earth or other material in accordance with usual construction and maintenance practices. Following expiration of the temporary construction servitude, the herein described temporary construction servitude area will be left free of construction scars and no maintenance will occur within that area.

GRANTOR acknowledges and agrees that the consideration provided herein constitutes full and final settlement for the perpetual servitude and temporary construction servitude herein granted and for any and all diminution in the value of GRANTOR's remaining property as a result of the granting of this perpetual servitude and temporary construction servitude. The consideration recited herein represents full and final settlement of all claims of any kind to the full extent of the GRANTOR'S loss, and specifically represents a compromise by all parties to avoid formal expropriation proceedings and the added expenses of litigation.

Except as expressly provided in any separate writing, no title examination or title opinion has been requested or performed on behalf of the GRANTEE by the undersigned Notaries Public or settlement agent, and the GRANTEE expressly rejects the necessity of the same and agrees to release and relieve the Notaries Public and settlement agent from any responsibility and liability in connection therewith.

The consideration for the herein described perpetual sewer servitude is the price and sum of SEVEN HUNDRED AND SEVEN AND 20/100 (\$707.20) DOLLARS, together with the amount of ONE HUNDRED AND SIX AND 08/100 (\$106.08) DOLLARS for the temporary construction servitude, for the total amount of EIGHT HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN AND 28/100 (\$813.28) DOLLARS, which GRANTEE has paid cash in hand, in current money, to said GRANTOR, who acknowledges the receipt thereof and grants full acquittance and discharge thereof.

The parties hereto agree and authorize GRANTEE to pay over unto MARTHA KING LAMBERT the consideration as herein stipulated in accordance with the right of usufruct authorized by the provisions of the Judgment of Possession in the matter of "The Succession of Edward Walter Lambert", Probate Number P-3015 of the 29th Judicial District Court for the Parish of St. Charles, State of Louisiana, signed by the Court on January 2, 1991, recorded on January 3, 1991 in COB 432, Folio 594, Entry No. 154795 of the official records of St. Charles Parish, Louisiana.

All ad valorem taxes assessed against the above described property for the three (3) years immediately preceding the current year have been paid.

This agreement shall be executed in triplicate, each of which shall constitute an original document which shall be binding upon any of the parties executing same. To facilitate recordation of this agreement, the parties hereto agree that individual signature and acknowledgment pages from the various counterparts may be merged and combined with signature and acknowledgment pages from other counterparts.





ORDINANCE NO. 23-3-7

An ordinance to approve a purchase and/or expropriation of a 1,477 sq. ft. perpetual sewer servitude and a 2,214 sq. ft. temporary construction servitude over property owned by Martha King Lambert, Edward W. Lambert, Jr., Sally Lambert Schexnaydre, and Mary Jane Lambert, and/or all other owners of record, as their interests may appear, designated as Lot 7 of the John Lambert Tract for the St. Rose Sewer Network Upgrade Project.

WHEREAS, St. Charles Parish is undertaking an upgrade to the St. Rose Sewer Network; and.

WHEREAS, the St. Rose Sewer Network has a history of problems related to deficiencies in the network; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed sewer network upgrade requires the acquisition of a temporary construction servitude and a perpetual sewer servitude over Lot 7 of the John Lambert Tract, Section 41, Township 12 South, Range 9 East, St. Charles Parish, Louisiana to construct, operate, and maintain a sewer line; and,

WHEREAS, the sewer network upgrade project and the acquisition of the hereinafter described servitudes are in the public's best interest and is in satisfaction of a public need; and,

WHEREAS, St. Charles Parish has provided just compensation offers and negotiated in good faith with the landowners, Martha King Lambert, et al., to acquire the necessary real estate interest at fair-market value established by a certified independent appraisal; and,

WHEREAS, in the event the landowners refuse to grant the necessary rights and the required real estate cannot be amicably acquired, St. Charles Parish will have no alternative than to acquire the required real estate through expropriation in accordance with the law; and,

WHEREAS, the properties are more particularly described on the drawing by Riverlands Surveying Co., LLC, dated February 1, 2018, revised May 27, 2020, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

THE ST. CHARLES PARISH COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION I. That the purchase and/or expropriation of a 1,477 sq. ft. perpetual sewer servitude and a 2,214 sq. ft. temporary construction servitude over the property owned by Martha King Lambert, Edward W. Lambert, Jr., Sally Lambert Schexnaydre, and Mary Jane Lambert, and/or all other owners of record, as their interests may appear, is hereby approved and accepted in the not-to-exceed appraised value of \$813.28.

SECTION II. That the Parish President is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to complete said purchase and/or expropriation on behalf of St. Charles Parish.
