WHEREAS, in June of 2000, Roland was appointed as the Executive Director of the Police Jury Association, making him the youngest State Executive Director in the Nation; and,

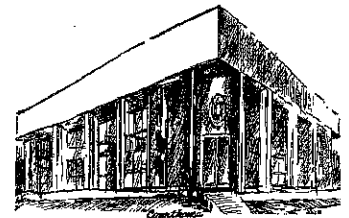
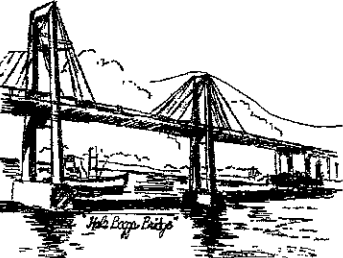
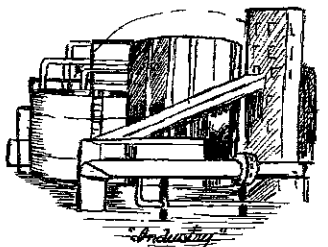
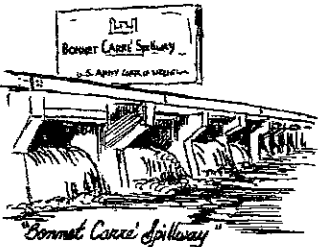
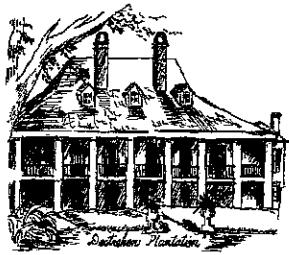
