An ordinance to amend the St. Charles Parish Code of Ordinances, Chapter 2, Administration, Article I. In General, by adding Section 2-16.6. Civil Service

Employee Pay Classification and Pay Plan Study.

WHEREAS, Civil Service Employees play a crucial role in ensuring continuity as Administrations shift; and,

**WHEREAS**, as the Parish grows and roles adjust, it is imperative to maintain current job descriptions and guarantee employees are compensated based on the tasks they perform.

**SECTION I.** That the Code of Ordinances, Chapter 2, Administration, Article I. In General, is hereby amended by adding Section 2-16.6 Civil Service Employee Pay Classification and Pay Plan Study with new text <u>underlined</u> and deleted text in <del>strikethrough:</del> as follows:

## Sec. 2-16.6 Civil Service Employee Pay Classification and Pay Plan Study

The Parish President shall have a Civil Service Employee Pay Classification and Pay Plan Study conducted every three (3) years from the effective date January 1, 2023.
