

**INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
STATE OF LOUISIANA
PARISH OF ST. CHARLES**

BE IT KNOWN that on this 6th day of January, 2004⁵
PERSONALLY CAME AND APPEARED:

ST. CHARLES PARISH, 15045 River Road, P.O. Box 302, Hahnville, Louisiana 70057, herein represented by Albert D. Laque, Parish President

AND

THE LAFOURCHE BASIN LEVEE DISTRICT, 21380 Highway 20, P.O. Box 670, Vacherie, Louisiana 70090, Herein represented by Kenneth Peltier, President who declare that they enter into this agreement.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Constitution and the Local Services Law of Louisiana allow for intergovernmental agreements among political subdivisions of the State of Louisiana; and,

WHEREAS, St. Charles Parish, in conjunction with the Lafourche Basin Levee District has been working on the West Bank Hurricane Protection Levee; and,

WHEREAS, construction has recently begun on Phase I of the project; and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Lafourche Basin Levee District to provide funding up to \$ 2,134,373.00 toward the Levee Project to settle any and all claims for funds owed by the Parish through August 31, 2004.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED THAT:

ST. CHARLES PARISH:

- 1) Shall continue with the construction of Phase I and continue the permitting process on the additional Phases, along with engineering of the West Bank Hurricane Protection Levee.
- 2) Shall select and employ the necessary persons to perform said work.
- 3) Shall invoice the Lafourche Basin Levee District for reimbursement of all expenses incurred in said project, up to the maximum of \$ 2,134,373.00

THE LAFOURCHE BASIN LEVEE DISTRICT:

- 1) Hereby agrees to allocate \$ 2,134,373.00 to the West Bank Hurricane Protection Levee project for the purpose stated.
- 2) Shall reimburse St. Charles Parish for all expenses incurred in said project, up to the maximum of \$ 2,134,373.00, upon being invoiced by St. Charles Parish.
