



TREATED 1.307 BILLION GALLONS OF SEWER IN 2019

HAULED 2,067 TONS OF SLUDGE TO THE LANDFILL*

*up approximately \$94,889.00.00


SEWERAGE TREATED = 2.864 billion gallons*
