
# GENERAL OPERATIONS & CAPITAL PROJECTS

- On-Demand service since February 2009
- Fare: \$2 one-way
- Service Hours: Monday Friday, 5:00am to 7:30pm and Saturday 5:30am to 7:30pm
- Connecting Service:
  - > St. James Parish Transit, JeT (Jefferson), and RTA (Orleans)
- Purchased three, 10-12 passenger vehicles in 2017 & two in 2018 equipped with:
  - Security Cameras
  - Wheelchair lifts
  - Bicycle racks

### **RIDERSHIP**

#### Total Ridership:


- 2018 Ridership was 18,231 (10.6% greater than 2017)
- 2019 YTD as of August 31 is 11,340
- 3 buses in service daily for a total15 hours



#### RIDERSHIP – ST. CHARLES PARISH

- Of the 11,340 total trips made as of August 31, 1,007 either originated or ended in St. Charles Parish.
- The vast majority, an estimated 86% of these trips, were work-related with people going to/from their places of employment.
- An estimated 12% of the remaining trips were to/from medical appointments (predominantly dialysis).

# **CLIENTS BY PARISH**





#### **INCREASED SERVICE**

## The RPTA has increased service twice in response to passenger demand.

- Saturday Service:
  - Began February 2014
  - > 2 buses in service for a total of 14 hours
- Weekday Extra Hour of Service:
  - Began March 2017
  - > 2 buses in service beginning at 5:00am rather than 5:30am

#### **CHALLENGES**

- Transit systems do not "pay for themselves" with fare revenue.
- Movement from more rural service to more urban areas has greatly reduced our income from the State.
- Total reimbursements have dropped over 18%.
- 2016-2018: 7% 20% of operational expenses were not reimbursed.
- By end of 2019, over 20% of operational expenses will not be covered.
- Most of the federal grant dollars allotted for operational costs & 0% local match (Hurricane Katrina) are no longer available.
- Other federal grants that were once available are no longer being offered by FTA.
- An increase in Federal and/or State funding is not anticipated at this time.

#### THE POTENTIAL FUTURE OF RPTA – FEASIBILITY ANALYSIS

- RPTA secured federal funding to perform a feasibility analysis.
- Goals of the feasibility analysis:
  - Maintain/improve a high-quality public transit service & connections to neighboring providers.
  - > Balance the needs of riders & budgetary constraints.
  - > Outline recommendations to increase system productivity & service.
  - Examine the relationship the transit system could play with the proposed Baton Rouge-New Orleans intercity rail system.

#### THE POTENTIAL FUTURE OF RPTA – FEASIBILITY ANALYSIS

Transit models to be considered include but are not limited to:

- demand response (the current system)
- fixed route
- a hybrid system
- partnering with other agencies
- the use of TNCs (Uber/Lyft) in conjunction with any of the systems
- Parishes operating their own systems

#### THE POTENTIAL FUTURE OF RPTA — FEASIBILITY ANALYSIS

- Anticipated Timeline:
  - October 2019 RFP released
  - December 2019 Proposal Submission
  - January 2020 Proposer Selected
  - July 2020 (or earlier) Feasibility Analysis Delivered
