WHEREAS, the St. Charles Parish Special Projects/Public Safety, Health, and Environmental Committee met on Monday, November 6, 2000; and,

WHEREAS, the members of the Committee unanimously voted to ask the Parish Council for their support in requesting the Administration to contact the State; and,

WHEREAS, there is a need for St. Charles Parish to be included in the Capital Outlay Program.
