IN RECOGNITION

WHEREAS, at approximately 1:45 pm, a woman was driving an SUV, with windows rolled down, and what appeared to be a toy tied to mardi gras beads to the passenger side mirror; and,

WHEREAS, **Ms. Jones** then realized that it was an actual puppy, being dragged for blocks. **Ms. Jones** tried stopping the occupant in the vehicle by laying on her horn, and yelling, eventually causing the motorist to stop; and,

WHEREAS, **Ms. Jones** ran up to the vehicle, asking the occupant to stop dragging the puppy and bring it to a vet or the shelter. **Ms. Jones** walked back to her car and noticed that the motorist continued dragging the puppy; and,

WHEREAS, **Ms. Jones** ran over to the vehicle again, at which time the motorist told **Ms. Jones** that she was trying to put the puppy out of its misery; and,

WHEREAS, at this point **Ms. Jones** was in disbelief and called the St. Charles Parish Sheriff's Office for a deputy to conduct a report; and,

WHEREAS, an Officer arrived on the scene and the occupant of the SUV was placed under arrest for animal cruelty; and,

WHEREAS, **Ms. Jones** was in the right place at the right time to rescue the puppy from a horrendous act of cruelty; and,

WHEREAS, **Ms. Jones'** act of kindness in saving the puppy reinforces the value of compassion and inspires others.

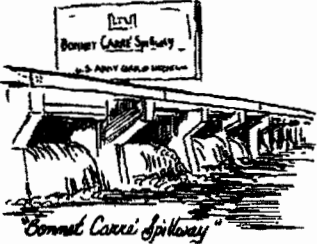

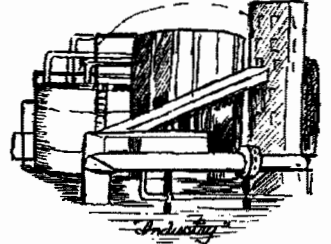

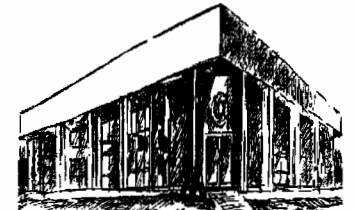
