ORDINANCE NO. <u>01-12-10</u>

An ordinance to revoke and abandon Wesco Road, in Norco, Louisiana, said property serving no public use.

WHEREAS, certain properties were laid out for use as a public street to be known as Wesco Road, within the Wesco Subdivision, in Norco, Louisiana; and,

WHEREAS, since the dedication, the property presently has no public use and/or benefit; and,

WHEREAS, St. Charles Parish Council desires to revoke said property as provided by law unto the present record owners of the adjacent property, reserving a twenty-five foot (25') drainage servitude along the west property line from the River Road to the Illinois Central Gulf Railroad tracks.

THE ST. CHARLES PARISH COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION I. That the Act of Revocation of dedicated property by the Parish of St. Charles is hereby approved subject to the twenty-five foot drainage servitude along the west property line from River Road to the Illinois Central Gulf Railroad tracks.

SECTION II. That the Parish President is hereby authorized to execute said Act of Revocation.

THE HONORABLE ALBERT D. LAQUE, Parish President and Chief Executive Officer of the Parish of St. Charles, herein duly authorized by the provisions of the Ordinance No. 01-12-10 passed and adopted at a meeting of the St. Charles Parish Council held on December 17, 2001

That pursuant to the above related ordinance, the Parish of St. Charles, through its governing authority, the St. Charles Parish Council, does hereby abandon and revoke the dedication of Wesco Road, said road being situated in a northerly direction from Louisiana Highway 48 (River Road) to the Illinois Central Gulf Railroad located in Section 6, Township 12 South, Range 8 East, St. Charles Parish, Norco, Louisiana; that the revocation of the above dedicated property herein is deemed to be in the best interest of the Parish, as such property no longer constitutes property utilized or needed by the Public, less and except a drainage servitude, and St. Charles Parish shall retain all of its rights and interest in a twenty-five foot (25') drainage servitude along the west property line from the River Road to the Illinois Central Gulf Railroad tracks in the survey of Lucien Gassen, File #950616, dated 10 13, 1996(attached hereto and made a part hereof), all of which the St. Charles Parish Department of Public Works and Wastewater requires in order to maintain adequate drainage for the surrounding property, including all rights of ingress and egress for the purpose of maintenance and utilization of said servitude.

Further, that pursuant to LA R.S. 48-701 et seq, the revocation of the dedicated property shall be made unto the present owners of the land contiguous thereto.
