An ordinance to approve and authorize the execution of an Act of Donation by the Pontchartrain Levee District to St. Charles Parish for the Bayou Labranche Scenic Areas Recreational Park.

DONOR HEREIN RESERVES UNTO THEMSELVES, THEIR SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS ANY AND ALL MINERAL RIGHTS IN AND TO SAID PROPERTY, DONOR FURTHER WAIVES ALL SURFACE RIGHTS UNTO SAID PROPERTY.

NO TITLE EXAMINATION WAS REQUESTED OF AND NONE WAS PERFORMED BY THE UNDERSIGNED NOTARY PUBLIC.
