Interested parties are hereby notified that the Coastal Management Division of the Department of Natural Resources has received the following application for a Coastal Use Permit in accordance with the State and Local Coastal Resources Management Act of 1978, as amended, (Louisiana R.S. 49, Sections 214.21-214.41), and the rules and regulations of the Coastal Resources Program.

Additionally, interested parties are hereby notified that an application has been received by the District Engineer for a Department of the Army permit to authorize the following pursuant to: [X] Section 404 of the Clean Water Act (86 Stat. 816; 33 USC 1344), [X] Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899 (33 USC 403).

Application has also been made to the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality, Office of Environmental Services for a Water Quality Certification in accordance with statutory authority contained in the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, Title 30, Chapter 11, Part IV, Section 2074 A(3) and Provisions of Section 401 of the Clean Water Act (P.,O. 95-217).

DESCRIPTION:

Proposed installation of approximately 87,870' of two 8" pipelines from the Tri-States valve site west of the Bonnet Carre Spillway to an Enterprise valve site which is located west of the Marathon Refinery in Garyville, LA. The proposed pipelines will parallel the recently constructed Wilprise and Bridgeline pipelines. A 50' x 300' workspace will be required at the Tri-States valve site. Two 50' x 400' workspaces will be required at the Woodlawn Canal crossing. Two 100' x 400' workspaces will be required for the directional drill of the first I-10 crossing. Two 100' x 400' workspaces will be required for the directional drill of the second I-10 crossing. Two 50' x 400' workspaces will be required at the Reserve Relief Canal crossing. The crossing of the Godchaux Canal will require four additional workspaces: a 100' x 400', a 100' x 200', a 25' x 294', and a 25' x 400'. A 100' x 200' workspace will be required on the wetland side of the east/west levee and a 100' x 400' workspace will be required in the upland side of the levee. Three 30' x 30' valve sites will be constructed at the Tri-States valve site, the Godchaux Canal, and the Reserve Relief

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Canal. A 50' construction right-of-way will be required in the wetland areas and a 70' construction right-of-way will be required in the upland areas. Approximately 73,500 cu. yds. of native material will be temporarily displaced during pipeline installation. Approximately 900 cu. yds. of water bottom material will be temporarily displaced if the contractor elects to open cut the canal crossings. Approximately 100 cu. yds. of limestone fill will be required for valve sites and approximately 75 cu. yds. of limestone will be required for bank stabilization if the contractor elects to open cut the canal crossings. Approximately 14.92 acres of forested wetlands may be impacted by the proposed project.**

**Habitat impacts are based on available in-house data and may not represent actual conditions. Field reconnaissance may be required to verify extent of impacts.

THE APPLICANT MUST SECURE A STATE COASTAL USE PERMIT PLUS A DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY PERMIT OR A GENERAL PERMIT AUTHORIZATION FROM THE CORPS OF ENGINEERS. INDEPENDENT EVALUATIONS AND DECISIONS WILL BE MADE BY THE COASTAL MANAGEMENT DIVISION AND THE CORPS OF ENGINEERS.

Plans for the proposed work are now on file and may be inspected at the Office of the Coastal Management Division, Department of Natural Resources, State Land and Natural Resources Building, 625 North 4th Street, Room 1011, Baton Rouge, LA 504/342-7591. Written comments, including objections to the proposed work and reasons therefore, and suggestions for modifications thereof, are solicited from anyone having an interest in the matter. Comments to the state of Louisiana must be mailed within 25 days of the date of official journal publication of this notice and must be addressed to the Coastal Management Division at P.O. Box 44487, Baton Rouge, LA 70804-4487. All comment letters should contain both the applicant's name and the application number.

State of Louisiana Coastal Use Permit Criteria

The decision on whether or not to issue a Coastal Use Permit will be based on an evaluation of the probable impacts of the proposed activity in accordance with the state policies outlined in R.S. 49:214.22. The decision will reflect the national concern for both protection and utilization of important resources. The decision must be consistent with the state program and approved local programs for affected parishes and must represent an appropriate balancing of social, environmental and economic factors. All factors which may be relevant to the proposal will be considered; among these are flood and storm hazards, water quality, water supply, feasible alternative sites, drainage patterns, historical sites, economics, public and private benefits, coastal water dependency, impacts on natural features, compatibility with the natural and culture setting and the extent of long term benefits or adverse impacts.

Certification that the proposed activity will not violate applicable water and air quality laws, standards and regulations will be required before a permit is issued.

State of Louisiana Water Quality Certification Criteria

In accordance with the Joint Public Notice Agreement between Coastal Management Division and the Office of Water Resources, notice is hereby given that the applicant has applied to the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality, Office of Environmental Services for a Water Quality Certification in accordance with statutory authority contained in the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, Title 30, Chapter 11, Part IV, Section 2074 A(3) and provision of Section 401 of the Clean Water Act (P.L. 95-217).

Comments concerning this application can be filed with the Office of Environmental Services within ten days of this notice to the following address: Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality, Office, Office of Environmental Services, P.O. Box 821355, Baton Rouge, Louisiana 70884.

Additional information is on file with the above office, and may be inspected at any time between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. weekdays. Copies may be obtained upon payment of cost of printing. A final decision on this application will be made within 60 days after publication of this notice.

Corps of Engineers Federal Permit Criteria

The decision whether to issue a permit will be based on an evaluation of the probable impacts including cumulative impacts of the proposed activity on the public interest. That decision will reflect the national concern for both protection and utilization of important resources. The benefits which reasonably may be expected to accrue from the proposal must be balanced against its reasonably foreseeable detriments. All factors which may be relevant to the proposal will be considered including the cumulative effects thereof; among those are conservation, economics, aesthetics, general environmental concerns, wetlands, historic properties, fish and wildlife values, flood hazards, floodplain values, land use, navigation, shoreline erosion and accretion, recreation, water supply and conservation, water quality, energy needs, safety,

food and fiber production, mineral needs, considerations of property ownership and, in general, the needs and welfare of the people.

The Corps of Engineers is soliciting comments from the public, Federal, state and local agencies and officials; Indian Tribes; and other interested parties in order to consider and evaluate the impacts of this proposed activity. Any comments received will be considered by the Corps of Engineers to determine whether to issue, modify, condition or deny a permit for this proposal. To make this decision, comments are used to assess impacts on endangered species, historic properties, water quality, general environmental effects and the other public interest factors listed above. Comments are used in preparation of an Environmental Assessment and/or an Environmental Impact Statement pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act. Comments are also used to determine the need for a public hearing and to determine the overall public interest of the proposed activity.

No properties listed in the National Register of Historic Places are near the proposed work. The possibility exists that the proposed work may damage or destroy presently unknown archaeological, scientific, prehistorical, or historical sites or data. Copies of this notice are being sent to the State Archaeologist and the State Historic Preservation Officer.

Our initial finding is that the proposed work would neither affect any species listed as endangered by the U.S. Department of Interior nor affect any habitat designated as critical to the survival and recovery of any endangered species.

The applicant has certified that the proposed activity described in the application complies with and will be conducted in a manner that is consistent with the Louisiana Coastal Resources Program. The Department of the Army permit will not be issued unless the applicant receives approval or waiver of the Coastal Use Permit by the Department of Natural Resources.


If the proposed work involves deposits of dredged or fill material into waters of the United States, the evaluation of the probable impacts will include the application guidelines established by the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency. Certification that the proposed activity will not violate applicable water quality standards will be required from the Department of Environmental Quality, Office of Water Resources before a permit is issued.

You are requested to communicate the information contained in this letter to any other parties whom you deem likely to have interest in this matter.

Public Hearings

Any person may request, in writing, within the comment period specified in this notice, that a <u>State</u> or <u>Federal</u> public hearing be held to consider this application. Request for public hearings shall state, with particularity, the reasons for holding a public hearing.

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

AND SECTIONS, 44, 29, 20, 19, 18, T115-R8E & 13, 97, 12, 66, 96, 10, 14,
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
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


