

**LOUISIANA LITTER ABATEMENT GRANT PROGRAM

1. PROJECT DESCRIPTION: (Please provide a complete and clear description of your implementation plan, program goals and objectives, budget and timeline.)

A. DESCRIPTION OF PROGRAM:

St. Charles Parish plans to hire a Litter Abatement Coordinator who will be responsible for establishing an educational program notifying the public about the Illegality of littering, the harm it does to the environment, the cost which is relegated to parish government, and the harm it does to the image of the parish.

B. IMPLEMENTATION PLAN:

We will work closely with the Constables and Justices of The Peace to have the current litter laws enforced while we work with the School Board and civic associations in educating the public about the litter problem; parishwide meetings will also be held.

C. PROGRAM GOALS AND OBJECTIVES:

Our objective is to have a person who will direct the efforts of litter abatement on a day to day basis; formulate an education program surrounding litter issues, development at a later date of a prevention and litter enforcement program for St. Charles Parish.

D. LOCALITY OR AREA IN WHICH THE PROGRAM WILL BE CONDUCTED:

Our litter program will be conducted parishwide.

E. TIMELINE: (dates and activities to be completed)

We plan to have the Litter Abatement Coordinator hired by August 1, 2002; by September 15th visits to the various schools in the area will begin. During the months of October, November and December all of the local civic organizations will be contacted and informed about the program and solicited to participate with the parish. The parishwide meetings will begin by January 15, 2003.

We expect to have the cooperation of the St. Charles Parish School Board and the St. Charles Parish Sheriff Department and the St. Charles Parish Beautification Committee. Several meetings including a breakfast meeting with the Sheriff Department and the Constables will be held. The Parish will continue this program with parish funds once the grant has been depleted.

A periodic meeting will be held with the Constables and Sheriff Department to monitor the progress of the program.
