2021-3-ORD Matthew Jewell, Parish President/Dept. of Planning and Zoning an ordinance to amend the St. Charles Parish Subdivision Regulations of 1981 Section IV. B. Design Standards for Sewer Systems.

Mr. Albert: Mr. Chairman the Director of Wastewater is here to explain the ordinance change and take any questions.

David DeGeneres, Director of Wastewater. What we're trying to do, we have a big infiltration problem right now in our sewer system. The previous ordinance allowed a slight infiltration when they tested the lines so we're trying to remove that line completely and the Parish President wants to go a little bit further where we want to actually inspect the line so we have a video requirement in there as well and then there's additional things like pull a mandrel through when a contractor lays a line, it doesn't compress because that will slow the flow down too because we're having a lot of flow problems as well. So we're trying to tighten it up for the contractor when they put it in that they're actually doing it correctly so that's what we can do to verify that it's getting done.
