SERVICES

Issue citations for violations of the parish animal ordinances.

Seize and impound dogs found to be at large. Issue warnings to dog owners for allowing their dogs to be at large, followed by patrols to assure compliance.

Quarantine animals that have bitten persons.

Rescue animals in distress and respond to calls for assistance on animal problems.

Accept unwanted animals.

Offer healthy dogs and cats for adoption and low cost spay / neutering sponsored by the St. Charles Humane Society.

Maintain lost and found file to reunite pets with their owners.

Investigate reports of cruelty to animals, take action to alleviate cruelty and prosecute those guilty of cruelty to animals.

Investigate reports of nuisances created by animals and seek cooperation of owners of offending animals to abate nuisances. Assist in prosecution of those animal owners allowing nuisances to persist.

Inspect and license animal breeders, grooming establishments and pet shops to assure high standards in the parish.
