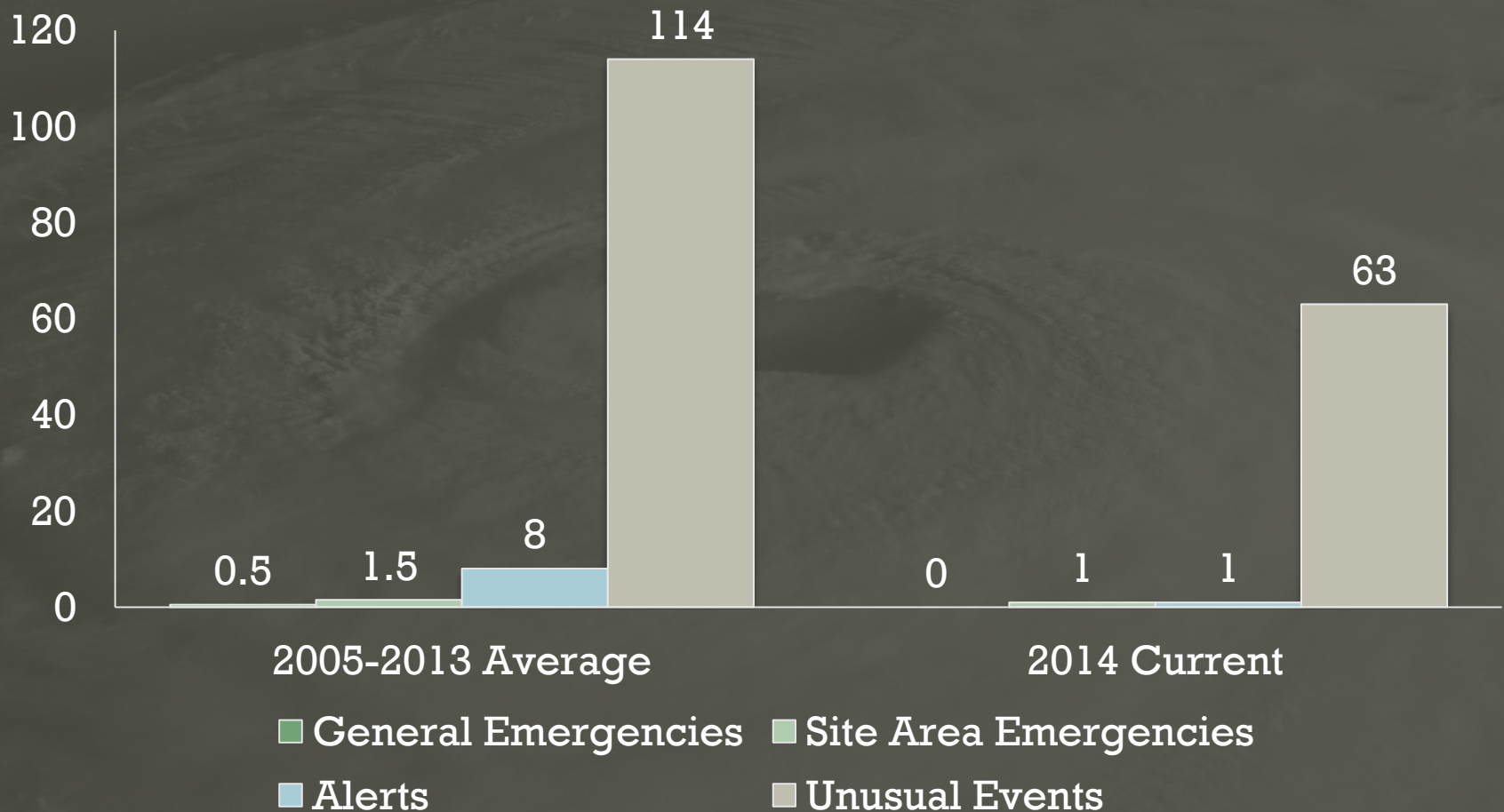
2005-2013 EOC Emergency Classifications

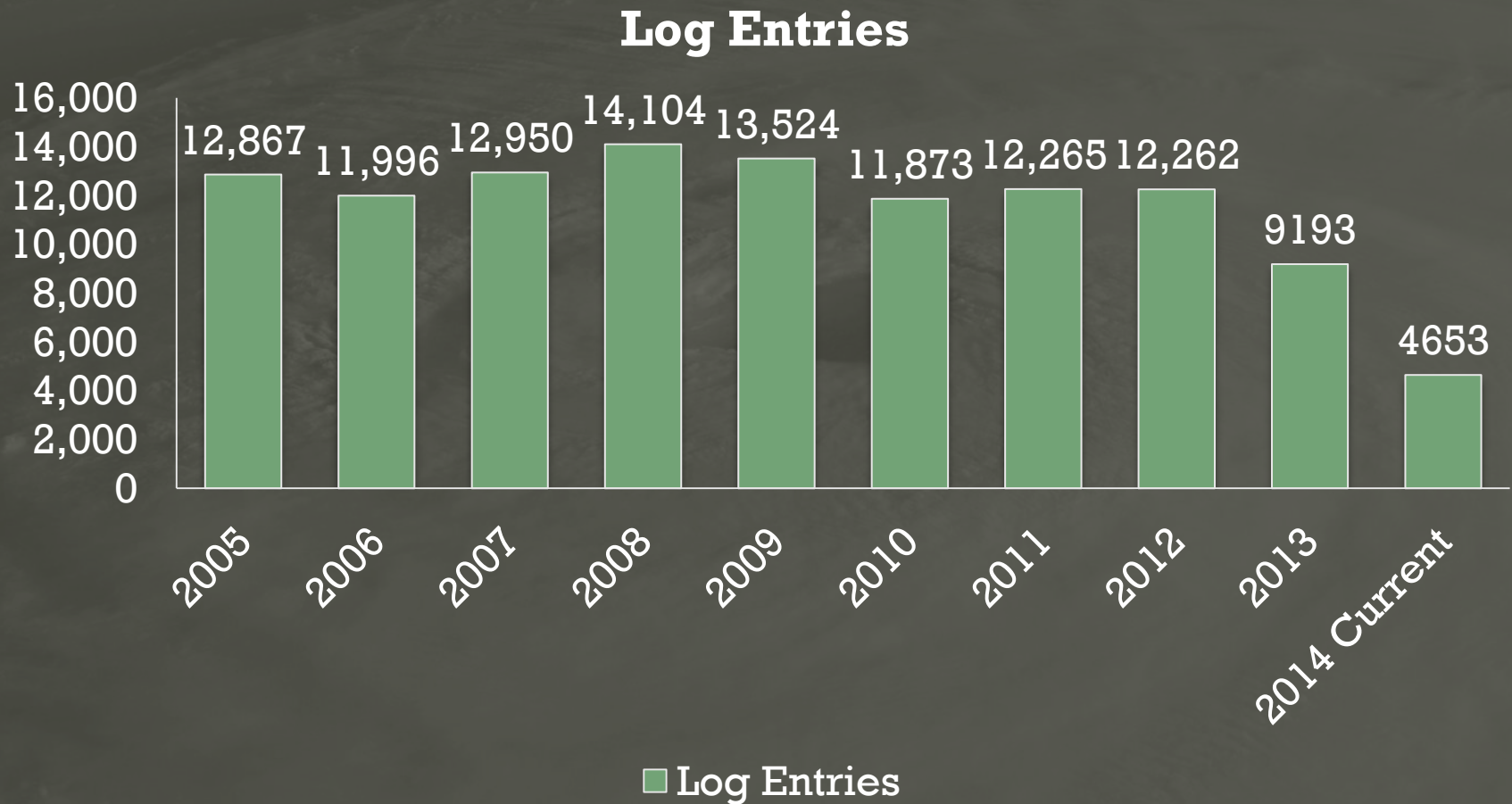
2005-2013 Average to 2014 Current
