WHEREAS, through Peter's determination, he wrote to the Committee of Management in London, England and received a charter on March 1, 1843 establishing the Philiomathean Order #646; and,

WHEREAS, through Peter's inspiration a group of men from Hahnville, Louisiana obtained a charter establishing the St. Charles Lodge Grand United Order of Odd Fellows #2842 on January 10, 1887; and,

WHEREAS, Hahnville Household of Ruth #1346, the sister organization, was established on May 9, 1899; and,

WHEREAS, Hahnville Juveniles #2405 was established on August 23, 1974 under the Leadership of Hahnville Household of Ruth; and,



#### Reason for Change Order:

1. a) and b) The support for the condenser water pumps was changed to maintain the roof warranty. The original concrete pads were deleted in favor of new structural steel supports. The roofing manufacturer determined the location of the concrete pads as shown on the drawings was too close to the adjacent wall structure to allow proper reroofing in order to maintain the roof warranty. Therefore a credit for the housekeeping pads was obtained.

c) and d) The support for the condenser water pumps was changed to structural steel to allow the roofing warranty to be maintained (see Item a above). In addition, the structural steel for the cooling tower required additional support to keep the vertical members from racking.

- e) and f) The condenser water pipe routing was modified to minimize the disruption the construction would have on the Sheriff's offices on the third floor. The piping was re-routed over the roof instead of through the third floor
- g) The amount of demolition was reduced with the relocation of the condenser water piping from the third floor ceiling space to the roof. Third floor ceilings were no longer required to be demolished and walls were not required to be penetrated.


