Flynn, PLS dated April 8, 2020, Deputy Jeff G. Watson Drive, Luling, as requested by Debra Dufresne Vial for Esperanza Land, LLC & Hank Tatje for T Times 4, LLC.

WHEREAS, Debra Dufresne Vial for Esperanza Land, LLC & Hank Tatje for T Times 4, LLC request a rezoning from M-2 to M-1 on Lots 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, & 19, Esperanza Business Park Phase 2, as shown on the Final Plan Esperanza Business Park Phase 2 by Stephen P.
