
## GENERAL OPERATIONS & CAPITAL PROJECTS

- On-Demand service since February 2009
- Fare: \$2 one-way
- Service Hours: Monday Friday, 5:00am to 7:30pm and Saturday, 5:30am to 7:30pm
- Connecting Service:
  - > St. James Parish Transit, JPT (Jefferson), and RTA (Orleans)
- Purchased two, 10-12 passenger vehicles and one support vehicle, in 2021 equipped with:
  - Security Cameras
  - Wheelchair lifts
  - Bicycle racks

#### **RIDERSHIP**

#### Total Ridership:


- 2020 ridership was 14,775
- 2021 YTD as of October
   31<sup>st</sup> is 10,405
- 3 vehicles in service for a total of 43 hours weekdays
- 2 vehicles in service for a total of 28 hours Saturdays



#### RIDERSHIP – ST. CHARLES PARISH

- In 2021, an average of 35% of all rides originated and 32% ended in St. Charles Parish.
- The majority were work-related with people going to/from their places of employment.
- The remaining trips were primarily to/from medical appointments (predominantly dialysis).

## **CLIENTS BY PARISH**




## INCREASED SERVICE

## The RPTA has increased service twice in response to passenger demand

- Saturday Service:
  - Began February 2014
    - > 2 buses in service for a total of 14 hours
- Weekday Extra Hour of Service:
  - ➤ Began March 2017
    - > 2 buses in service beginning at 5:00am rather than 5:30am

## **CHALLENGES**

## Transit systems do not "pay for themselves" with fare revenue.

- Movement from more rural service to more urban areas has greatly reduced our income from the State.
- 2017-2019: 7%-16% of operational expenses were not reimbursed by Federal/State funds.
- Several Federal grants that were once available are no longer being offered by FTA.
- Beginning March 2020, the RPTA has received 100% CARES Act funding from FTA and the State.

## A NEW WAY TO RPTA

- In April 2021, the RPTA rolled out a 90-day soft launch of the Cityway's LINK application followed by a hard launch in August.
- LINK is an on-demand service scheduling system that allows passengers the ability to book trips on the RPTA website as well as the app available on Apple and Google Play stores.
- Passenger response has been extremely positive with nearly 79% of all bookings being made through the website or app and average trip ratings of 4.88 stars.
- Moreover, shared booking rates are higher, and mileage and fuel consumption are lower - thereby making the system overall much more efficient and cost-effective.
