RESOLUTION NO. 6156

A resolution providing for canvassing the returns and declaring the results of the special election held in the Parish of St. Charles, State of Louisiana, on Saturday, May 2, 2015, to authorize the levy of a special tax (levees) therein.

BE IT RESOLVED by the St. Charles Parish Council (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of the Parish of St. Charles, State of Louisiana (the "Parish"), that:

SECTION 1. Canvass. This Governing Authority does now proceed in open and public session to examine the official tabulations of votes cast at the special election held in the Parish of St. Charles, State of Louisiana, on SATURDAY, MAY 2, 2015, to authorize the levy of a special tax (levees) therein, and said Governing Authority does further proceed to examine and canvass the returns and declare the results of the special election.

SECTION 2. Procès Verbal. A *Procès Verbal* of the canvass of the returns of said election shall be made and a certified copy thereof shall be forwarded to the Secretary of State, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, who shall record the same in his office; another certified copy thereof shall be forwarded to the Clerk of Court and *Ex-Officio* Recorder of Mortgages in and for the Parish of St. Charles, who shall record the same in the Mortgage Records of said Parish; and another copy thereof shall be retained in the archives of this Governing Authority.

SECTION 3. Promulgation of Election Results. The results of said election shall be promulgated by publication in the manner provided by law.

The foregoing resolution having been submitted to a vote, the vote thereon was as follows:

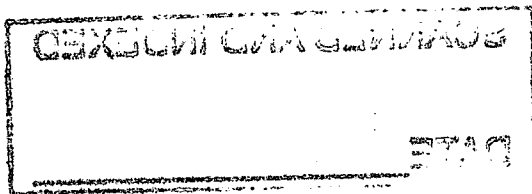

BE IT KNOWN AND REMEMBERED that on Monday, May 18, 2015, at six o'clock (6:00) p.m., at its regular meeting place, the Council Chambers, 15045 Hwy. 18 (River Road) Hahnville, Louisiana, the St. Charles Parish Council (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of the Parish of St. Charles, State of Louisiana (the "Parish"), and being the authority ordering the special election held therein on Saturday, May 2, 2015, with the following members present: Lewis, Wilson, Woodruff, Hogan, Cochran, Fletcher, Fisher-Perrier



Pursuant to the provisions of a resolution adopted by the St. Charles Parish Council (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of the Parish of St. Charles, State of Louisiana (the "Parish"), on March 2, 2015, NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a special election will be held within the Parish on **SATURDAY, MAY 2, 2015**, and that at the said election there will be submitted to all registered voters in the Parish qualified and entitled to vote at the said election under the Constitution and Laws of the State of Louisiana and the Constitution of the United States, the following proposition, to-wit:

MILLAGE PROPOSITION

Shall the Parish of St. Charles, State of Louisiana (the "Parish") levy a special tax of four (4) mills (the "Tax") on all property subject to taxation in the Parish (an estimated \$4,800,000 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the Tax for an entire year), for a period of thirty (30) years, beginning with the year 2015 and ending with the year 2044, for the purpose of paying any costs associated with constructing, acquiring, maintaining, operating, extending and/or improving levees, facilities and structures associated with outer flood protection systems within the Parish?






