 - 1. Original Oath of Office filed with Secretary of State by mail at P.O. Box 94125, Baton Rouge, LA 70804-9125 or hand delivery at 8585 Archives Ave., Baton Rouge, LA 70809.

the commissioned public servant must acknowledge receipt of the Louisiana Code of Governmental Ethics when filing their Oath of Office. By signing above, you have complied with La R.S. 42:1162.

- 2. <u>Duplicate original</u> Oath of Office filed with the parish Clerk of Court. (In Orleans Parish file with the Clerk of Civil District Court.)
- 2. All Oaths of Office must be filed for recording within one month of being taken.
- 3. Failure to take an Oath of Office within 30 days creates a vacancy in office, to be filled in accordance with law. IMPORTANT: Taking an Oath of Office does <u>not</u> automatically vacate a public officer's present office, if any. A notice of retirement or resignation may be necessary to vacate a present office.
- 4. An Oath of Office taken early (prior to the date shown on the commission) is not effective until the term of office begins or upon the date of the commission.
