January 1 - December 31, 2017

- ▶ The Collection
 - ► Added 26,202 new items
- Circulation
 - ▶ Physical Materials: 205,568 (↑ 1.25%)
 - ► E-books: 25,424 (↑ 2.1%)
 - ► Total Circulation (all formats): 230,992 (↑ 1.34%)
- ▶ Technology
 - ► Use of public computers: 55,372 (↑ 6.5%)
 - ▶ Database Usage: 141,773 (↑ 13.71%)
 - ► Use of free Wi-Fi: 25,172 (\$\dagger\$ 8.72%)

January 1 - December 31, 2017

General Attendance

- ▶ 143,263 visits to our 6 branches
- ▶ Bookmobile made 2,385 visits to patrons
- ► Total Attendance increased by 4.4% from 2016

Program Attendance

- ► A total of 1,488 programs held for children, teens, and adults (↑ 21.8%)
- ▶ 29,094 attendees (↑ 33.3%)








Building Updates Norco Branch Status
