River Birch Renewable Energy

- Service approximately 37,000 carts per week
- Less than 1% verifiable complaint ratio in the past 8 months
- Sustained newly created tracking methods & response times with RBRE

TRASH BASH 2026

Trash Bash 2026:

- 364 Volunteers collected over 300 bags of trash
- Covered over 215 miles of roadway (collectively)

Road Lighting

- **Completed Parish Wide Streetlight Audit**
 - Over 850 streetlights repaired so far in since last meeting. 30% increase in $\frac{3}{4}$ of the time; from November 2025
- **Completed work on existing projects including Hale Boggs Bridge Lighting, High Mast Lighting (-1), and Historical Lights**
- **Researched new projects to begin preparations on for 2026**
- **Sustained new tracking system for lighting that is currently saving an average of \$1,000 per month in warranty work**
- **Sustained newly created 2025 reporting method for Entergy owned streetlights**

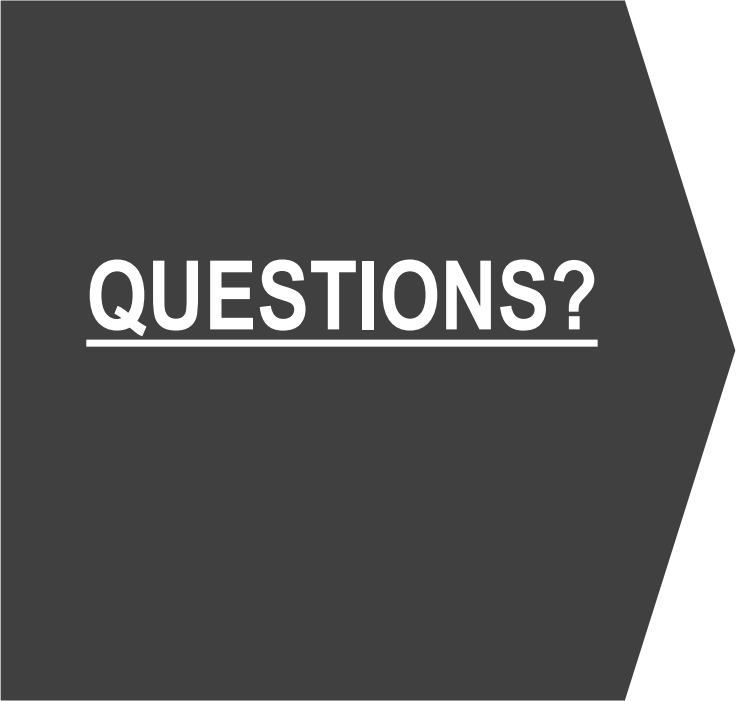
VDCI / MOSQUITO CONTROL

As of 6/9/2026

- **Over 6,100 miles and 260,000 acres sprayed**
- **112 service calls completed**
- **Over 14,000 acres aerial sprayed**
- **Contract requirements are being met**

Emergency Storm Debris Removal and Disposal

- **5 Emergency Debris Sites identified and certified in preparation if needed**
- **Communicate as needed to remain ready**
- **Attended multiple meetings w/ new Debris Monitor Contract while adding great capabilities to DRC's contract: Waterway Clearance**
- **Plan to attend annual FEMA/GOHSEP class in Tangipahoa Parish to sustain familiarity with all things regarding how we react to Emergency Debris Removal**
