IMPORTANT: Taking an Oath of Office does not automatically vacate a public officer's present office, if any. A notice of retirement or resignation may be necessary to vacate a present office.
- 4. An Oath of Office taken early (prior to the date shown on the commission) is not effective until the term of office begins or upon the date of the commission.
