CONTRACTOR: Contractor shall remain responsible for security of equipment and materials, safety, and maintenance during completion of punchlist items. In relation to the generator, enclosure, fuel tank and accessories, contractor shall maintain all warranties and guarantees of materials and workmanship for a period of five years after the substantial completion date, in full accordance with Article 13.12 of Section 00700 of the Parish Courthouse Emergency Stand-by Generator Documents.
