ORDINANCE NO. 05-6-13

An ordinance to renew the Citizens' Recycling Committee as a standing Committee of the Parish Council.

- WHEREAS, continue education process in recycling and effects on the Parish and citizens for the long-term; and,
WHEREAS, continue interaction with the children in the school system with help from the contractor who is awarded the Recycling contract; and,
WHEREAS, investigate and make a recommendation for a compost program involving organic material, lawn clippings, leaves and other garden waste; and,
WHEREAS, make recommendation for the disposal of large tree cuttings, household appliances and construction material disposal as a self sustaining activity with reasonable assessment of fee for homeowner; and,
WHEREAS, address the Parish Council at least once a year with a progress report and use of the contractor for educational purposes.

THE ST. CHARLES PARISH COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION I. That the Citizens' Recycling Committee becomes a standing Committee of the Parish Council.
