THE ST. CHARLES PARISH COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS:
SECTION I. That the Code of Ordinances, Chapter 6. Buildings and Building Regulations, Article II. Building and Related Construction Codes, Section 6-14. Permit Application be amended by adding the following after item (I): Prior to the issuance of the building permit, the applicant shall furnish the Department of Planning and Zoning with a Sewer Permit issued by the Department of Wastewater. Should the applicant be unable to obtain the Sewer Permit due to 1) non-availability of an adjacent public sewer line, or 2) the inability to install an onsite method for processing the sewage due to installation requirement constraints, the applicant shall be refunded the building permit application fee. No permit shall be issued by the Planning and Zoning Department without having first received all required permit application checklist items listed on the permit application. The Parish Council shall be provided a copy of any revised standard building permit application document within 1 week of any revision. The revised application document shall be attached to a letter from the Planning and Zoning Department detailing the revision or revision on the document form.
