
DESCRIPTION:

Approximately 6,000 cu. yds. of sand and 2,210 cu. yds. of concrete will be hauled in and used as fill to construct a $\pm 674' \times 375'$ multi-family housing complex which includes $16 - \pm 82' \times 26'$ multi family units, paved roadways and parking areas. Approximately 3.5 acres of bottomland hardwoods will be impacted as a result of this project. Approximately 2 acres of bottomland hardwoods was cleared prior to obtaining authorization.*






