According to NOLA.com, in 2019 suicide rates in Louisiana had risen by more than 29 percent. Historically, after communities are faced with traumatic experiences suicide rates increase. since 2019 our community has been impacted by COVID-19 and the destruction of Hurricane Ida.

in April of 2022 the **House Committee** on Education reported, 37% students reported being sad 18% reported they have thought of how they would commit suicide. These signs can help raise awareness for resources.

There is hope.

According to the national suicide prevention lifeline, bridge signs are the most costeffective and most effective first line intervention measure when attempting to prevent suicide.

Bridges that have incorporated prevention signs have seen a significant decrease in the number of suicide attempts. Locations such as the Golden Gate Bridge, Coronado Bay Bridge, and the Bloor street Viaduc Bridge in Toronto claim to have seen a decrease suicide attempts in general, suggesting the signs prompted many to seek mental heath care before it was too late.

Studies suggests that placing signs promoting a hotline number near bridges that people frequently travel increased crisis calls from an individual's home, car or another location further preventing suicide attempts in the communities where signs are placed

This initiative will remind others that they are not alone and they are needed which indirectly improves overall mental health.

Hale Boggs Bridge is a historic symbol for our parish. Recent events have caused there to be negative attitudes toward the bridge. Through sharing messages like there is hope, you are not alone, and you are needed, the bridge can be a reminder that St. Charles Parish is the parish that cares and Hale Boggs helps us live united.



Hale Boggs Bridge as a symbol of hope and infrastructure that unites our parish




Funding
