WHEREAS, in accordance with authority granted by Constitution of the State of Louisiana, in order to serve the public for the purposes hereinafter declared, St. Charles Parish and the River Road Historical Society entered into this Cooperative Endeavor Agreement.

WHEREAS, in order to preserve a local, historic asset, St. Charles Parish agrees to the relocation of the *Bethlehem Hall* to the grounds of Destrehan Plantation, and;

WHEREAS, in accordance with authority granted by Constitution of the State of Louisiana, in order to serve the public for the purposes hereinafter declared, St. Charles Parish and the River Road Historical Society entered into this Cooperative Endeavor Agreement.

The River Road Historical Society hereby agrees to the following:

- Provide the St. Charles Parish Department of Economic Development & Tourism with office space within the Destrehan Plantation Welcome Center and Store or provide property near the public entrance to the grounds of Destrehan Plantation to accommodate the St. Charles Parish Tourist Information Center Office.
- Provide the space or property to St. Charles Parish free of charge.
- Provide signage indicating the presence of the St. Charles Parish Tourist Information Center Office.
- Relocate historic *Bethlehem Hall* to a prominent location on the premises of Destrehan Plantation and utilize the structure in its operations.
- Acknowledge and commemorate the history of *Bethlehem Hall* in its offerings to visitors.
- Provide information, reports and documentation requested by the St. Charles Parish Department of Economic Development & Tourism.

St. Charles Parish hereby agrees to the following:

- Operate and manage the St. Charles Parish Tourist Information Center.
- Allow the relocation of historic Bethlehem Hall to the grounds of Destrehan Plantation.
