### ACT 179 of the 2023 Regular Session of the Louisiana Legislature

Who is a Qualified First Responder by definition of Act 179:

#### 1. Volunteer Firefighter:

A. who has completed (within the tax year) no fewer that 24 hours of firefighter continuing education, **AND** 

- B. an active member of the Louisiana State Fireman's Association, OR
- C. on the departmental personnel roster of the Volunteer Firefighter Insurance Program.
- D. Does **NOT** have to be full-time.
- E. Does **Not** have to reside in the Parish.

(A + [B or C] = qualified)

#### 2. "First Responders"

- A. Full-time public (must be government employees) employees:
  - a. Must be Full-Time.
  - b. Duties include responding rapidly to an emergency. (don't actually have to respond, just included in their duties).
  - c. Must <u>reside</u> in the Parish of employer.
  - d. Term includes the following:
    - Peace officer Sheriff, Police officer, Other person deputized by proper authority to serve as a peace officer (State Police, DWLF, FBI, ATF, CIA, Secret Service or others).
    - ii. Fire protection personnel.
    - iii. Certified emergency medical services personnel.
    - iv. Emergency response operator or emergency services dispatcher (Home Land Security?).

#### Steps to implement exemption:

- 1. MUST be approved by Parish governing body.
- 2. Assessor establishes a procedure (application).
- 3. Must apply annually.
  - a. Retirees do not qualify.
  - b. Surviving Spouses do not qualify.
- 4. Can only qualify in the tax year applying.

SENATE BILL NO. 127

#### BY SENATOR DUPLESSIS

1	A JOINT RESOLUTION
2	Proposing to add Article VII, Section 21(0) of the Constitution of Louisiana, relative to ad
3	valorem tax exemptions; to provide for an ad valorem tax exemption for certain first
4	responders; to require the parish governing authority to approve the ad valorem tax
5	exemption; to provide for exemption amounts; to require the tax assessor to establish
6	a procedure to apply for the exemption; to provide for eligibility; to require taxing
7	authorities to absorb the loss of revenue as a result of the exemptions; to provide
8	relative to reappraisals; to provide an effective date; to provide for applicability; and
9	to specify an election for submission of the proposition to electors and provide a
10	ballot proposition.
11	Section 1. Be it resolved by the Legislature of Louisiana, two-thirds of the members
12	elected to each house concurring, that there shall be submitted to the electors of the state, for
13	their approval or rejection in the manner provided by law, a proposal to add Article VII,
14	Section 21(O) of the Constitution of Louisiana, to read as follows:
15	§21. Other Property Exemptions
16	Section 21. In addition to the homestead exemption provided for in Section
17	20 of this Article, the following property and no other shall be exempt from ad
18	valorem taxation:
19	* * *
20	(O)(1) In addition to the homestead exemption authorized pursuant to
21	the provisions of Article VII, Section 20 of this constitution, which applies to the
22	first seven thousand five hundred dollars of the assessed valuation of property,
23	a parish governing authority may approve an ad valorem tax exemption of up
24	to two thousand five hundred dollars of the assessed valuation of property
25	receiving the homestead exemption that is owned and occupied by a qualified

first responder.
(2) For the purposes of this Paragraph, "first responder" shall mean a
volunteer firefighter who has completed within the tax year no fewer than
twenty-four hours of firefighter continuing education and is an active member
of the Louisiana State Firemen's Association or is on the departmental
personnel roster of the Volunteer Firefighter Insurance Program of the office
of state fire marshal. For the purposes of this Paragraph, "first responder"
shall also mean a full-time public employee whose duties include responding
rapidly to an emergency and who resides in the same parish in which their
employer is located. The term includes the following:
(a) Peace officer, which means any sheriff, police officer, or other person
deputized by proper authority to serve as a peace officer.
(b) Fire protection personnel.
(c) An individual certified as emergency medical services personnel.
(d) An emergency response operator or emergency services dispatcher
who provides communication support services for an agency by responding to
requests for assistance in emergencies.
(3) The exemption provided for in this Paragraph shall only apply in a
parish if it is approved by the parish governing authority.

(4) Each tax assessor shall establish a procedure whereby a person may annually apply for the exemption which shall include the production of documents by the first responder. In the application for the exemption, the first responder shall produce documentation issued by his employer evidencing employment for the taxable period for which the exemption is being requested.

(5) Notwithstanding any provision of this constitution to the contrary, any decrease in the total amount of ad valorem tax collected by the taxing authority as a result of an ad valorem tax exemption granted pursuant to this Paragraph shall be absorbed by the taxing authority and shall not create any additional tax liability for other taxpayers in the taxing district as a result of any subsequent reappraisal and valuation or millage adjustment.

1	Implementation of the exemption authorized in this Paragraph shall neither
2	trigger nor be cause for a reappraisal of property or an adjustment of millages.
3	Section 2. Be it further resolved that this proposed amendment shall be submitted to
4	the electors of the state of Louisiana at the statewide election to be held on November 18,
5	2023.
6	Section 3. Be it further resolved that this proposed amendment, if approved by the
7	electors, shall become effective on January 1, 2024, and shall apply to ad valorem taxes due
8	beginning in tax year 2024 and thereafter.
9	Section 4. Be it further resolved that on the official ballot to be used at said election,
10	there shall be printed a proposition, upon which the electors of the state shall be permitted
11	to vote YES or NO, to amend the Constitution of Louisiana, which proposition shall read as
12	follows:
13	Do you support an amendment to authorize the local governing authority of
14	a parish to provide an ad valorem tax exemption for qualified first
15	responders?
16	(Adds Article VII, Section 21(O))
