Good afternoon, CSFI stakeholders,

With the NFIP's current reauthorization expiring September 30, and Risk Rating 2.0 set to take effect for new policies on October 1, we want to make you aware of a few developments this week:

- The House-passed stop-gap spending bill includes an extension of the NFIP through December 3, 2021
- A bipartisan group of senators, led by Majority Leader Chuck Schumer (D-NY) and Sen. Bill Cassidy (R-LA), sent a
 letter to FEMA today, urgently requesting a delay in Risk Rating 2.0 implementation. You can read the letter

- Last week, Reps. Bill Pascrell, Jr. (D-NJ) and Garret Graves (R-LA) led a letter signed by 38 members of Congress urging a Risk Rating 2.0 delay. You can read the letter here.
