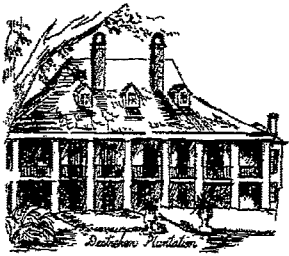

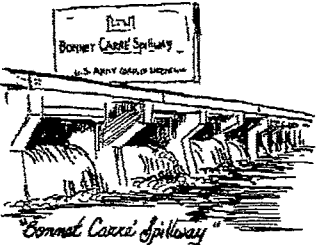
IN RECOGNITION



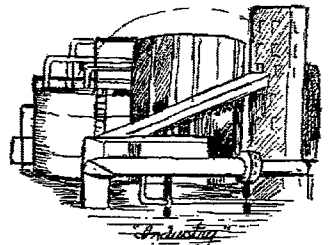

WHEREAS, Quinn has spent the last 12 years as an active member of the Scouts spending the last 7 years preparing to become an EAGLE SCOUT; and,



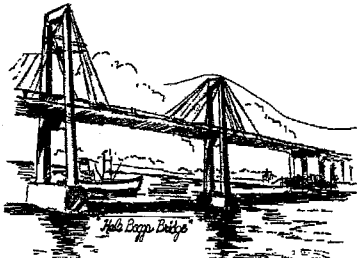
