ORDINANCE NO. 03-3-7

An ordinance to approve an Intergovernmental Agreement by and between St. Charles Parish and the Lafourche Basin Levee District for the continued funding of the West Bank Hurricane Protection Levee.

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Constitution and the Local Service Law of Louisiana allow for Intergovernmental agreements among the political subdivisions of the State of Louisiana; and,

WHEREAS, St. Charles Parish, in conjunction with the Lafourche Basin Levee District has been working on the West Bank Hurricane Protection Levee; and,

WHEREAS, construction has recently begun on Phase I of the Levee; and, WHEREAS, the current cost estimate to continue this project is \$500,000.00.

THE ST. CHARLES PARISH COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION I. That the Intergovernmental Agreement, State of Louisiana, Parish of St. Charles, by and between St. Charles Parish and the Lafourche Basin Levee District is hereby approved.

SECTION II. That the Parish President is hereby authorized to execute said agreement on behalf of St. Charles Parish.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Lafourche Basin Levee District to provide funding up to \$500,000.00 toward the Levee Project.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED THAT:

ST. CHARLES PARISH:

- Shall continue with the construction of Phase I and continue the permitting process on the additional Phases, along with engineering of the West Bank Hurricane Protection Levee.
- Shall select and employ the necessary persons to perform said work.
- 3) Shall invoice the Lafourche Basin Levee District for reimbursement of all expenses incurred in said project, up to the maximum of \$ 500,000.00

THE LAFOURCHE BASIN LEVEE DISTRICT:

- 1) Hereby agrees to allocate \$ 500,000.00 to the West Bank Hurricane Protection Levee project for the purpose stated.
- Shall reimburse St. Charles Parish for all expenses incurred in said project, up to the maximum of \$ 500,000.00, upon being invoiced by \$t. Charles Parish.
