ORDINANCE NO. 88-11-2

An ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 87-4-6 adopted April 6, 1987, to provide for annual reminders to industry on furnishing an annual report to the Parish of St. Charles.

THE ST. CHARLES PARISH COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION I. That Ordinance No. 87-4-6 requires that industry shall provide to the Governing Authority of St. Charles Parish an annual report accounting for those monetary benefits derived from operating under the Louisiana Industrial Inducement Program; and,

SECTION II. That this annual report shall be filed at the office of the Parish Council Secretary within thirty (30) days of the close of each calendar year; and,

SECTION III. That this ordinance should be amended to provide annual reminders to industry.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, THAT WE, THE MEMBERS OF THE ST. CHARLES PARISH COUNCIL, do hereby amend Ordinance No. 87-4-6 to provide that an annual notice with a maximum of two (2) follow-up reminders be furnished to industry making them aware of the ordinance; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the ordinance shall be further amended to stipulate that the Parish Council Secretary shall at a public meeting provide the Council with the names of those companies who are in violation of Ordinance No. 87-4-6 as amended.

ORDINANCE NO. 87-4-6

An ordinance mandating that industry shall provide to the Governing Authority of St. Charles Parish an annual report accounting for those monetary benefits derived from operating under the Louisiana Industrial Inducement Program.

THE ST. CHARLES PARISH COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION I. That the State of Louisiana has adopted legislation providing for an Industrial Inducement Program to promote the location of business and industry in the State; and,

SECTION II. That one of the aspects of the program provides a five year ad valorem tax exemption to industry engaged in manufacturing in Louisiana said exemption may be extended for an additional five-years; and,

SECTION III. That in addition to the tax-exemption provisions of the Louisiana Industrial Inducement Program, provisions also permit Governing Authorities to issue bonds in the name of the Parish to finance additions or improvements to existing industrial plants solely for pollution control; and,

SECTION IV. That further benefit was afforded industry in St. Charles Parish when on October 1, 1979 the St. Charles Parish Police Jury adopted an ordinance and approved the organization of the Industrial Development Board (under the provisions of State Legislation) "for the purpose of promoting stimulating, developing and advancing the business prosperity and economic welfare of the Parish of St. Charles and the State of Louisiana and the citizens thereof by: a) encouraging and assisting in the organization of new businesses and industries in said Parish and State and; b) rehabilitating and assisting, existing businesses and industries and; c) stimulating, assisting in the expansion of all kinds of business activities which will promote the business development in said area, ..."

NOW, THEREFORE, WE, THE MEMBERS OF THE ST. CHARLES PARISH COUNCIL, DO HEREBY ORDAIN that it shall be mandatory for any firm or corporation having the privilege to locate in the State of Louisiana, Parish of St. Charles, to provide the Governing Authority of St. Charles Parish with an annual report accounting for those monetary benefits derived from operating under Louisiana's Industrial Inducement Program.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the initial report for calendar year 1986 shall be filed at the office of the Parish Council Secretary within 30 days from the effective date of this ordinance; thereafter reports shall be due within 30 days of the close of each calendar year.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this report shall include the total number of persons employed at the facility and the total number of those employees who reside in St. Charles Parish.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the provisions of this ordinance shall apply only to business and industry participating in State or Parish Inducement Programs.
