Lee, I had a chance to review the drawings for the bike path and have some concerns with the path alignment and design on the west side of the Bonnet Carre' Spillway. Our operations at Bonnet Carre' often require bringing trucks and equipment on the levee crown between the existing ramp and SC-12. Also, often we have operations that will block the bike path in this area. The drawings indicate the crown of the levee in this area is to only receive 4 inch thick asphalt pavement (2 inch base course, 2 inch wearing course). The bike path will be damaged by our normal operations. My recommendation is to drop the bike path down on the south side of the ramp and run the path nearer to CC Road then back up again along the side of SC-12.

I know COVID-19 is causing issues with face-to-face meetings, however, I am available to meet to discuss further.

We do have a waiver to work at 15' stage but the due to the limitations imposed the contractor is hesitant to work. I expect the contractor to ask for time to re-stake and recheck grade for stone already put in. Depending on when the crane is coming in I suspect the asphalt will already be in. I also believe that the asphalt is thicker (6" instead of 4") on the levee portion due to truck traffic for the sand pit.


