

INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
ST. CHARLES PARISH
AND
LULING VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT

This Agreement is made and entered into on this 26th day of April, 2004,
by and between:

St. Charles Parish, 15045 Highway 18, Hahnville, LA 70057, herein represented by
Albert D. Laque, its Parish President, duly authorized by Ordinance No. 04-4-1 adopted on the
5th day of April, 2004.

AND

The Luling Volunteer Fire Department of the Parish of St. Charles, State of Louisiana,
67 St. Anthony St., Luling, LA 70070, herein represented by John Heath, its
President, duly authorized by Resolution of the Luling Vol. Fire Dept. adopted on
the 13th day of October, 20043

- WHEREAS,** the Constitution of the State of Louisiana and the Local Services Law of the
State of Louisiana provided for political subdivisions to engage in cooperative
endeavors for public purposes with any public or private association, corporation
or individual; and
- WHEREAS,** both the Parish of St. Charles, State of Louisiana (the "Parish") and the Luling
Volunteer Fire Department of the Parish of St. Charles, State of Louisiana (the
"Department") are authorized by law to provide fire protection service; and,
- WHEREAS,** there exists a need to purchase a fire truck for the Department; and,
- WHEREAS,** the Department is not in a financial position to purchase said truck without funds
being made available to cover the expense until sales tax bonds are issued from
the one-eighth of one-percent (1/8%) sales tax authorized by an election held in
the Parish on December 8, 1979 (the "Bonds"); and
- WHEREAS,** it is the desire of the Parish President and the Parish Council to provide said
funds to be repaid to the Parish from the issuance of the Bonds in accordance
with the terms of the Intergovernmental Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED THAT:

St. Charles Parish shall:

- 1) Appropriate and allocate up to \$270,000 for the purchase of a 2004 equipped E-One Truck on a Typhoon chasis for the Department, being the cost of said truck determined by public bid.
- 2) Provide said funding in one payment upon execution of this Agreement on or about April 15, 2004.
- 3) When the Bonds are issued, to deduct the debt service of the \$270,000 being used to repay the Parish for the advance from the amount normally distributed to the Department.

Luling Volunteer Fire District shall:

- 1) Assume all liability for the purchase of the fire truck and hereby agrees to indemnify and save harmless the Parish from and against any and all claims, suits, damages, costs (including attorney's fees) losses and expense which it may suffer or pay out by reason of, resulting from or arising out of the purchase of said fire truck.
- 2) Execute any required documents necessary to facilitate the object of this Agreement.
