




Councilman Dufrene was elected to the St. Charles Parish Council on October 12, 2019, taking office January 13, 2020, as District IV, Councilman.



Councilman Dufrene served as a member of the Special Projects/Public Safety, Health, and Environmental Committee and as Chairman for 2021, he served as a member of the Operations, Maintenance and Construction Management Committee and as Chairman for 2022 and 2023, and as a member for four years.
