**Question for the Council at the May 19, 2003 Council Meeting  
regarding the Ballpark North of Highway 90 in Des Allemands**

On April 29, 2003, I made a counteroffer for the Parish to the last offer I presented to the Parish on July 14, 2002. The counteroffer is to lease the 2.56 acre ballpark for \$1.00 / month through the end of September, 2003 followed by a short-term lease (such as the contemplated for the site on J.B.Green Road) for \$483/month for 36 months.

The wooded J.B. Green Road site the Parish is considering is 2.0 acres and has a lease amount of \$400/month (\$200/acre).

The cleared ballpark site I am offering is 2.56 acres and is offered at \$483/month (\$189/acre).

1. Has the Parish had time to consider the offer I presented three weeks ago on April 29, 2003?
2. If the Parish has considered the offer, what was decided regarding the offer?
3. If the Parish has not considered the offer as of today, then when will it be taken under consideration? Summer is here and the community is in desperate need of a park.
  - a. Will the "J.B Green site being wooded" as compared to the "ballpark site being cleared" be taken into consideration?
  - b. Will the ballpark being over ½ an acre larger than the J.B. Green site be taken into consideration?
  - c. Will the cost associated with "preparing the J.B. Green site for use" as compared to "no expenditures being required to immediately put the ballpark into service" be taken into consideration?
  - d. Will the community's majority opposition to the park being located on J.B. Green Road (an alleged drug street) be taken into consideration?
  - e. Will the fact that the majority of the children will be more endangered by having to walk on the road or the shoulder to the J.B. Green site than they would if they were walking to the ballpark site be taken under consideration?
  - f. Will the fact that the ballpark site was used for over 50 years and is preferred by the community majority be taken under consideration?
  - g. Will the fact that the ballpark site has a existing pitching mound and back-stop (re-fencing required) be taken into consideration?
