
The Parish of St. Charles

Ten years later, they bought the land where Pierre's Grocery was erected and is now Pierre's Beauty and Barber Shop on River Road in Ama, Louisiana. Irving and his wife Evelyn were in business for over 50 years; and,

WHEREAS. Irving was baptized in 1950 at Mt. Zion Baptist Church in Ama, LA. Irving became a Deacon in 1955. In 1957, he was elevated to the position of Head Deacon, where he served faithfully in that capacity for 63 years. He was also President of the Mt. Pilgrim's Society for over 13 years; and,

Irving is a member of the American Legion, having served as Commander and Agitant. He is also a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars, where he held the office of Treasurer; and,


