An ordinance placing a MORATORIUM on the installation of raised rumble strips on any/all streets in St. Charles Parish until December 31, 2012.

**WHEREAS,** it is the desire of the Parish Council to place a one year MORATORIUM on the installation of raised rumble strips as an evaluation period on the effectiveness of these traffic calming devices.

## THE ST. CHARLES PARISH COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS:

**SECTION I.** That there is hereby imposed a MORATORIUM on the installation of raised rumble strips on any/all streets in St. Charles Parish until December 31, 2012.

**SECTION II.** That this MORATORIUM shall not apply to any raised rumble strips previously approved for installation or currently installed should a replacement of that device be necessary.
