ORDINANCE NO.: 02-11-10

An ordinance asking the Administration to add St. Marks Street in Ama to Road Maintenance 2001-2002, Parish Project No. P000801.

WHEREAS, sealed bids were received by the Parish on September 6, 2002 and Barriere Construction Company, L.L.C. was the apparent low bidder for Road Maintenance 2001-2002; and,

WHEREAS, on October 7, 2002, the Administration was approved and authorized to execute a contract with Barriere Construction Company, L.L.C. for Road Maintenance 2001-2002; and,

WHEREAS, St. Marks Street is the only ingress and egress to and from several public facilities, including a park, baseball field, and church, and is in poor condition due to deterioration since the last road maintenance report.

THE ST. CHARLES PARISH COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION I. That the Administration is hereby authorized to add St. Marks Street in Ama to Road Maintenance 2001-2002, Parish Project No. P000801.
