- Repetitious comments and subject matter will be strictly limited.

RIGHT TO DIRECT PARTICIPATION COUNCIL GUIDELINES

No person shall be denied the right to observe and, within Council guidelines, to address the Council provided that the person has submitted a written request containing the detailed nature of the subject to be discussed which must be germane to the Powers and Functions of the Parish Council and Government. No person shall be permitted to address the Council on the same subject matter upon which he/she has previously addressed the Council during the prior eight week period. All requests and pertinent information must be received by the Council Secretary at least one (1) week prior to the scheduled meeting. (Home Rule Charter, Article VII, Section I.)

Each person may speak once no longer than five (5) minutes except with two-thirds consent of the Council, an additional three (3) minutes may be granted to either individuals or groups. Any representative of a group addressing the Council shall state the complete name of the group in the letter request, and shall furnish the Council with a letter signed by a simple majority of the members of the Board of Directors of the group, organization or association stating permission to address the Council; the date and time that meeting was held giving said permission; and the subject to be addressed. A bonafide charter of the organization certified (ratified) by the State of Louisiana shall be filed with the Council Secretary. A current list of Executive Officers and/or Board Members shall be submitted to the Council Secretary annually or when changes occur.

IMPORTANT NOTICE - PLEASE READ! Official Notice Regarding the Service of Raw Oysters Effective May 1, 2011 The Louisiana Administrative Code, Title 51, Public Health Sanitary Code, Part XX III, Chapter II, §II 09. Raw Shellfish Consumer Information Message [formerly paragraph 22:08-5. 1] A. states:

All establishments that sell or serve raw oysters must display signs, menu notices, table tents, or other clearly visible messages at point of sale with the following wording:

"THERE MAY BE A RISK ASSOCIATED WITH CONSUMING RAW SHELLFISH AS IS THE CASE WITH OTHER RAW PROTEIN PRODUCTS. IF YOU SUFFER FROM CHRONIC ILLNESS OF THE LIVER, OR BLOOD OR HAVE OTHER IMMUNE DISORDERS, YOU SHOULD EAT THESE PRODUCTS FULLY COOKED."

The wording of the Raw Shellfish Consumer Information Message cannot be shortened or altered in any way. The point of sale has been defined as any location in the establishment that a customer can order or be served raw oysters. If the Raw Shellfish Consumer Information is only placed on the menu, that would not be considered adequate notification. It is recommended that the consumer alter be displayed in more than one form. i.e. table tents, signage, etc. Failure to post according to the regulation will result in a critical violation and corrective action must be taken immediately.
