SUBJECT: "4-way Stop Sign" request for Milling Ave. and Third St.

We have reviewed the request for the installation of a 4-way "STOP" sign at the intersection of Milling Avenue and Third Street in Luling. According to the Manual On Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) a "STOP" sign must be warranted where one or more of the following conditions exist:

1. Intersection of a less important road with a main road where application of the normal right-of-way rule is unduly hazardous.
2. Street entering a through highway or street.
3. Unsignalized intersection in a signalized area.
4. Other intersections where a combination of high speed, restricted view, and serious accident record indicates a need for control by the "STOP" sign.

Since there is a high volume of traffic that passes through this intersection and the normal right-of-way rule is unduly hazardous, we recommend placement of "STOP" signs on Milling Avenue. Placement of these signs would create a 4-way stop intersection.
