Two certain lots or portions of ground with all the buildings and improvements thereon, all the rights, ways, privileges, servitudes and

Whenever the word "vendor" is used it this act, it shall be construed to include "vendors," and whenever the word "purchaser" is used it shall be construed to include "purchasers."

All the agreements and stipulations herein contained, and all the obligations herein assumed shall inure to the benefit of and be binding upon the heirs, successors, and assigns of the respective parties hereto

The certificate of mortgages required by Article 3364 of the revised Civil Code of Louisiana is hereby dispensed with by the parties hereto
