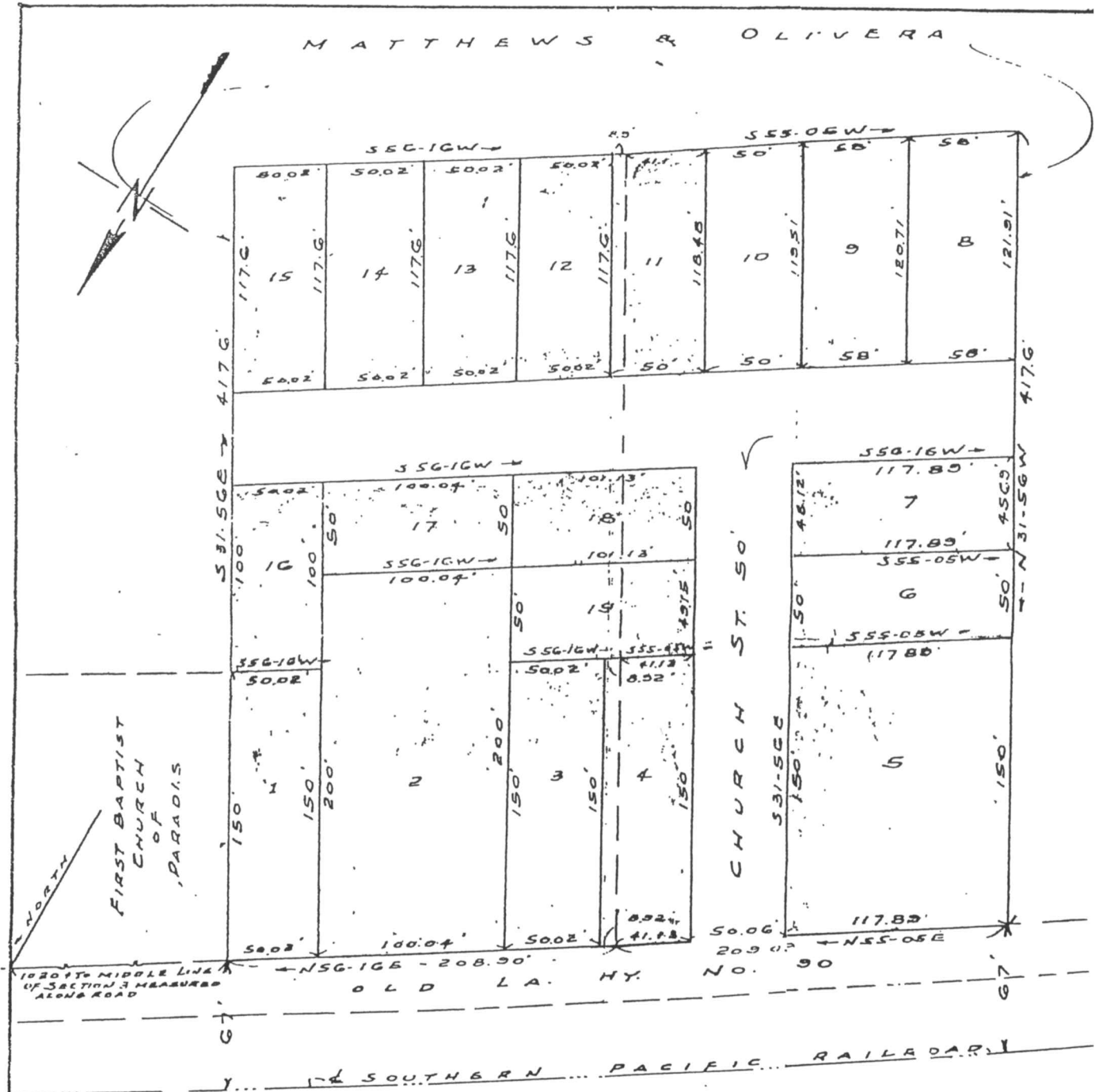

I am writing in response to your memorandum regarding Church Street in Paradis. A review of the Council Records does not reveal a dedication of Church Street in Paradis. The current Church Street was laid out on a survey entitled "Sub-Division of Portion of Property Of William Gastauer (see C.O.B. DD – Folio 588) at Paradis, St. Charles Parish, LA" by E. M. Collier dated January 21, 1968 which is on file in the Clerk of Court's Office on page 68A of the Ward 7 Map Book. A prior survey dated December 15, 1966 can also be found in C.O.B. 63 – Folio 40, Entry No. 30,152 of the Clerk of Court's Office.

Therefore, it appears to be an implied dedication which establishes a servitude of public use on the property of William Gastauer. In regards to your question as to the ownership of the underlying property a cursory review would indicate that the owners would be the heirs of William Gastauer.
