  - 1. Original Oath of Office filed with Secretary of State by mail at P.O. Box 94125, Baton Rouge, LA 70804-9125 or hand delivery at 8585 Archives Ave., Baton Rouge, LA 70809.
  - 2. <u>Duplicate original</u> Oath of Office filed with the parish Clerk of Court. (In Orleans Parish file with the Clerk of Civil District Court.)
- 2. All Oaths of Office must be filed for recording within one month of being taken.
- 3. Failure to take an Oath of Office within 30 days creates a vacancy in office, to be filled in accordance with law. IMPORTANT: Taking an Oath of Office does not automatically vacate a public officer's present office, if any. A notice of retirement or resignation may be necessary to vacate a present office.
- 4. An Oath of Office taken early (prior to the date shown on the commission) is not effective until the term of office begins or upon the date of the commission.
